members and clinicians are working together, in partnership, to improve the quality and safety of care. While this partnership should be integrated within all levels of your hospital (see graphic below), the time when this is this partnership is most direct is during the day-to-day care experiences that occur within the walls of your hospital.

To meet the HIIN goal of saying "Yes" to 4 of 5 best practice metrics on the operational survey, hospitals should:

- Set the stage of partnership by creating a quide that staff can use in pre-operation conversations (example), or provide an educational handout to understand how they can be a partner (example). · Create an environment that is not just tolerant, but welcoming of active engagement
- by making opportunities to be involved during shift-change huddles, or bedside reporting (<u>example</u>).
