

Does your patient with an Indwelling Urinary Catheter need a urine culture?

Is the patient symptomatic? Adults with UTI may present with ≥ 1 of the following symptoms with no other recognized cause. *Fever (>38.0°C), Suprapubic tenderness, Costovertebral angle pain or tenderness* YES The patient has one or more of the NO above symptoms None of the above symptoms Is the Indwelling Urinary Catheter still • Disregard the appearance or smell of clinically indicated? urine (e.g. cloudy, sediment, foul smelling) • Disregard positive urinalysis results for protein, leukocytes, blood, or nitrite NO Yes Remove catheter and send Has the catheter been in place **Clean Catch Urine for culture** for greater than **72 hours**? DO Not collect any urine specimens for culture. Yes No Replace catheter and send urine Collect sample from sampling sample from new catheter. port and send urine for culture
