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Succeeding Under Bundled Payment: Picking Post-Acute Providers to Ensure Financial Survival

OVERVIEW

This webinar will address the opportunities and challenges with successful participation in the Bundled Payment Care Initiative primarily, but not solely, from the perspective of Post-Acute Care. In 2013, CMS selected the NSLIJ Health System to participate in several Model 2 bundled payment initiatives including stroke, cardiac, valve, CABG, COPD and joint replacement. The owned post-acute care entities of the Health System effectively led bundling efforts by selecting bundling-compatible post-acute partners, developing clinical and business models of implementation and forecasting and adapting to the changes impacting both acute and post-acute care providers. This webinar will speak to the selection process and the criteria used in choosing the most appropriate postacute care providers, how the clinical strengths were assessed and how hospital resources were utilized to help strengthen the clinical skill sets of the post-acute care providers. The webinar will also cover the implementation of the clinical and business models developed for bundled payment including the use of clinical guidelines across all levels of care, the role of the care concierge, identification of dedicated units and clinical teams within participating facilities, importance of scripting and patient education and rehospitalization prevention initiatives. Lastly, the impact on the acute and post-acute care providers will be discussed including the benefits and challenges between partnering with owned postacute providers versus non-owned providers, the impact of a shortened hospital length of stay and accepts of patients to a skilled nursing facility (SNF) without a three-day hospital stay qualifier and the financial impact of bypassing SNF providers (loss of SNF volume as patients discharged home after hospital stay and development of other SNF services to backfill the void).
