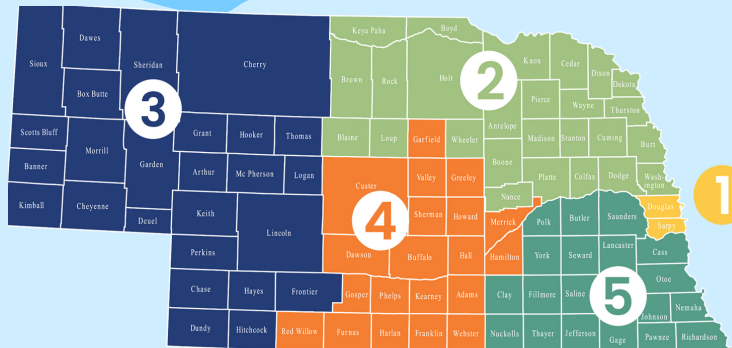


Top Health Needs Per Nebraska Region

REGION 1

Hospitals N=11, CHNA N=11
Mental Health and Nutrition/Physical Activity/Weight - 9 (81.8%).
Substance Abuse, diabetes, sexual health, injury/violence, heart disease/stroke, tobacco use, infant health/family planning, potentially disabling conditions- 8 (72.7%).

REGION 2

Hospitals N=16, CHNA N=15
Mental Health -10 (66.6%)
Heart disease, Cancer - 4 (26.6%)
Getting enough exercise, Diabetes- 3 (20%)
Retention of healthcare workers, obesity, drugs, aging workforce - 2 (7.5%)

REGION 3

Hospitals N=5, CHNA N=5
Mental health problems/increase access to mental health/behavioral health - 3 (60%)
Chronic disease management/increase prevention education to reduce the prevalence of chronic disease, preventable conditions, readmissions, and high mortality rates- 2 (40%)
Aging population, cancer, child abuse/neglect, food insecurity, high blood pressure, domestic violence, suicide - 1 (20%)

REGION 4

Hospitals N=10, CHNA N=9
Cancer-4 (44.4%)
Diabetes -3 (33.3%)
Getting enough exercise -3 (33.3%)
Social Determinants of Health, Violence & Injury, Injury, Mental Health, Mental Health & Substance Abuse -1 (11.1%)

REGION 5

Hospitals N=14, CHNA N=13
Mental Health/(Diagnosis/Treatment/Aftercare)/ Behavioral Health-5 (38.46%)
Behavioral Health/Mental Health Issues-4 (30.7%)
Cancer Care/Cancers/Cancer Care & Prevention-5 (38.4%)
Chronic & Infectious Disease, Social Determinants of Health, Violence & Injury- 2 (15.3%)
Affordable Healthcare Insurance, Violence, Child Abuse/Neglect, Motor Vehicle Crash Injuries & Death-1 (7.6%)
