  - Make it easy, and focus on learning, not perfection
  - Start with the end in mind

  - What are we trying to accomplish?
  - How will we know that a change in an improvement?
  - What changes can we make that will result in an improvement?

- Tool to help initiate planning of your improvement project
  - Team and Project
  - Drivers, Process Measures, and Goals
