Undergraduate Health Care Career Scholarship Program

Considering the importance and complexities of high-quality health care in today's society, it is critical for bright, talented people to be encouraged to pursue professions in the field. With that in mind, the NHA Research and Educational Foundation offers the Undergraduate Health Care Career Scholarship Program, designed for students interested in a career in health care. These scholarships support future leaders in their efforts to earn a high-quality education. This scholarship is available to students enrolled in an accredited program leading to a degree in health care. Examples of approved programs include, but are not limited to, RN to BSN, Radiologic Technologist Program, Medical Laboratory Technologist Program, etc. Non-clinical degrees are also eligible.

The undergraduate award is \$2,500 for the academic year.

Graduate Studies Tuition Aid Program

This scholarship is awarded to students pursuing a graduate degree in health care at an accredited college or university or an accredited institution offering online degree programs. The purpose of the scholarship is to assist with tuition and academic expenses in the form of an award of \$5,000 for an academic year.

Laura J. Redoutey Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to the most outstanding applicant and can be awarded to either an undergraduate or graduate student. This \$5,000 award is named for our NHA past president who served the association and its members for 21 years.

Requirements:

- ☐ Applicants must be employed by a member hospital of the Nebraska Hospital Association for at least one year.
- Applicants must be pursuing a health care degree from an accredited program.
- □ Applicants must be enrolled at an educational institution from one of the following states: Nebraska, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, North Dakota, or South Dakota. Online programs must have a presence in one of those states.

Application Must Include:

- Completed application form.
- Documentation from the hospital that you have been employed for at least one year.
- □ A program acceptance letter from your educational institution. The letter must contain your student ID# and the complete institution name, address, and phone number of the financial aid/business office.
- ☐ A typed Personal Statement reflecting your reason(s) for choosing health care as a career as well as your professional goals.
- ☐ Two completed reference letters. One reference must be from your direct supervisor or Hospital CEO.



Frequently Asked Questions

Question #1:

Are the children of NHA member hospital employees eligible?

Question #2:

I am planning on starting classes in the fall. Am I still eligible?

Question #3:

Am I still eligible if I am not a full-time student?

Question #4:

I am not employed by an NHA member hospital, but a hospital clinic. Am I still eligible?

Question #5:

I am earning my degree in business. Am I still eligible?

Question #6:

I will be graduating in the summer. Am I still eligible for the scholarship?

Question #7:

I am currently active in the military with the possibility of deployment during the next academic year. Am I still eligible for the scholarship?

Answer #1:

Only if they are also employed by an NHA member hospital.

Answer #2:

Yes, if you have been accepted by the institution and enrolled in the program.

Answer #3:

Yes, there is no required credit hour minimum. If your course(s) contribute to a health care degree or certification and the fee isn't significantly lower than the award, you may still be eligible.

Answer #4:

Yes, if the clinic is owned by a NHA member hospital.

Answer #5:

Yes, if the degree is utilized in a health care setting, but preference is given to clinical health care degrees.

Answer #6:

You're only eligible if you'll be continuing your education for at least one more semester, as scholarship funds are distributed in August for fall and spring semester tuition.

Answer #7:

Yes, scholarship funds are distributed directly to the educational institution and remain available through financial aid while you're enrolled. If your status changes (e.g., you're no longer a student), the funds are forfeited and returned to the NHA Foundation.
