NHA recognizes Class XIII Leadership Institute graduates

LINCOLN, Neb. — The Nebraska Hospital Association (NHA) Leadership Institute graduated its 13th class on October 12, 2016.

The NHA Leadership Institute, which now has 318 alumni, is a 10-month intensive leadership development program designed specifically for hospital middle managers and health care leaders who want to refresh their leadership skills.

The 35 Class XIII graduates were honored before more than 500 people in attendance at the NHA Awards Banquet on Oct. 12 at Embassy Suites Omaha-La Vista Hotel & Conference Center in La Vista, which is in conjunction with the 89th Nebraska Hospital Association Annual Convention.

Participants in the intensive leadership development program, designed specifically for hospital managers, completed 40 hours of instruction and training, individualized reading, personality assessments, feedback exercises and management coaching.

They also engaged in a variety of leadership-oriented topics, including building a foundation of leadership, using 360-degree assessments for improved leadership, working with conflict, analyzing performance issues, personality traits in the workplace, coaching for improved performance, leading across the generations, leading teams and succession management.



"We are very proud of this year's graduates of the NHA Leadership Institute as they have demonstrated a desire and commitment to becoming exceptional health care leaders for Nebraska," NHA President Laura J. Redoutey said.
